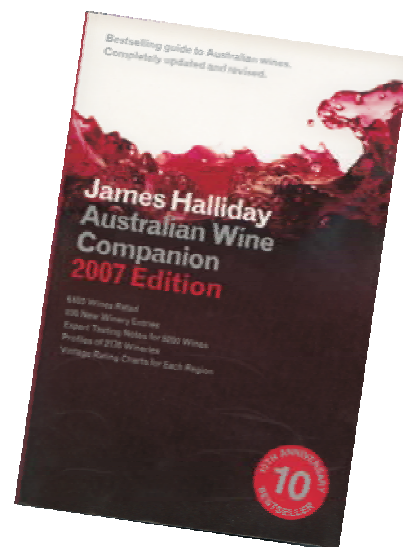

John Zilm Barossa Valley Shiraz 2004

Intense and elegant, with silky mouth-feel and great length; plum, spice, blackberry and even blackcurrant; seamless oak and tannins.

Allyson Parsons Barossa Valley Shiraz 2004

Dense red-purple; rich blackberry, blood plum, dark chocolate and spice; medium-bodied, moderate alcohol a pleasure; fine, ripe tannins.
Screwcap. 14 alc. **Rating 94 Drink 2016**

John Zilm Barossa Valley Merlot 2004

Strong colour; medium to full bodied; generous cassis/plum fruit, supple and smooth, but alcohol takes away from the varietal profile. So may the addition of a little Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot.

Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2004

Extremely powerful, concentrated full bodied wine; black fruits and dark chocolate, the tannins still very assertive; probably enough fruit to carry the tannins, but don't touch for five, better still, ten years.

Barossa Valley Grenache 2004

Super ripe, ultra juicy Grenache floods the mouth with fruit.

Adelaide Hills Viognier 2005

Abundant apricot and peach varietal flavour; medium bodied, good balance and acidity.
Screwcap. 14.5 alc **Rating 89 Drink 2008**
