Viticulture / Production

- Appellation: Barossa Valley
- Basket pressed
- 90% Cabernet Sauvignon / 10% Merlot
- Wood: American and French oak
- Barrel maturation: 16 months
- Viticultural notes: Vines are pruned to a two bud spur. Vines are located throughout the Barossa Valley. The soil ranges from a heavy brown loam to a sandy loam.

- Baume: 15.8
- pH: 3.85
- Total Acid: 5.65

In Bottle

- Alcohol: 15.5%v/v
- pH: 3.65
- Total Acid: 6.70g/l
- Free/Total SO₂: 15/58
- Residual Sugar: 3.7g/l

Wine Maker's Notes

- Colour: Black red with a purple hue
- Nose: Spice with black berry characters and a hint of tobacco leaf
- Palate: Rich black fruit with subtle fine grained tannins.

Tasting Notes

A complex wine with great length. Maturation in American and French oak has given the wine excellent structured tannins. Lovely rich black fruit character on both the nose and palate complement the traditional Cabernet mintiness.
