## Viticulture / Production

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- Appellation: Barossa Valley
- Basket pressed
- 87% Grenache / 8% Mourvèdre / 5% Shiraz
- Wood: French oak Hogs Heads
- Barrel maturation: 4 months
- Viticultural notes: Fruit was sourced from the Ebenezer area within the Barossa Valley. Soil is a heavy brown loam. Vines are spur pruned.

- pH: 3.79
- Total Acid: 6.70

- Alcohol: 15.0%v/v
- pH: 3.68
- Total Acid: 6.23g/l

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- Colour: Magenta
- Nose: Raspberry, cherry, spice
- Palate: A full flavoured wine that has style and finesse.

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The wine is rich, ripe and subtle with a finish that is mouthfilling, long and lingering.
