Viticulture / Production

- Appellation: Barossa Valley
- Basket pressed
- 40% Cabernet Sauvignon / 20% Merlot / 20% Shiraz / 20% Grenache
- Wood: American and French oak
- Barrel maturation: 16 months
- Viticultural notes: Various vineyards were used to source the fruit. The majority of vines are spur pruned. Soil types range from sandy through to heavy brown loam.

- pH: 3.65
- Total Acid: 6.45

In Bottle

- Alcohol: 15.5%v/v
- pH: 3.67
- Total Acid: 7.27g/l
- Free/Total SO₂: 10/28

Wine Maker's Notes

- Colour: Magenta
- Nose: Savoury, black fruits and oak nuances
- Palate: Fruit driven with integrated tannins and lovely spice

Tasting Notes

This wine displays a savoury yet fruit driven palate with a lovely spicy nose. The soft tannins and maturation in some new French oak add a lovely complexity to the wine.
