Viticulture / Production

- Appellation: Barossa Valley
- Basket pressed
- 86% Shiraz / 14% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Wood: American and French oak.
- Barrel maturation: 16 months
- Viticultural notes: Heavy brown loam soil.
Vines are spur pruned to a two bud spur.
The fruit was sourced from the Tanunda area within the Barossa Valley.

Chemical Analysis

At Picking

- Baume: 15.5
- pH: 3.68
- Total Acid: 6.45

In Bottle

- Alcohol: 15.5%v/v
- pH: 3.61
- Total Acid: 6.67g/l
- Free/Total SO₂: 7/30
- Residual Sugar: 4.16g/l

Wine Maker's Notes

- Colour: Black with rich purple hues
- Nose: Berries, rich spice, plums
- Palate: Integrated spice and berry fruit flavours.

Tasting Notes

The spiciness of this wine is complemented by the rich fruitcake characters. A wonderfully, well balanced wine of a rich purple/black colour with fantastic fruit purity.
