Tasting Notes

This Shiraz has a brick red colour with touches of purple on the hue. Both the nose and palate are dominated by fruit flavours of luscious forest berry characters, plum and a touch of spice. The palate has great length and structure finishing with soft smooth tannins. An overall fruit forward style Shiraz with hints of oak.
