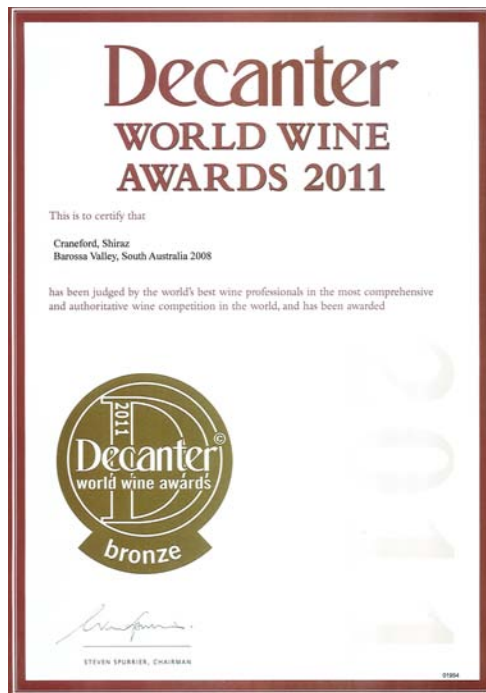

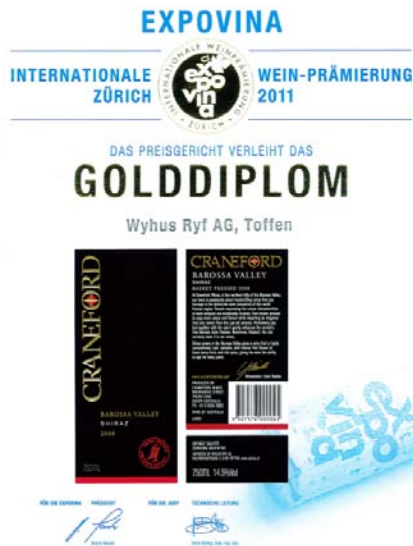

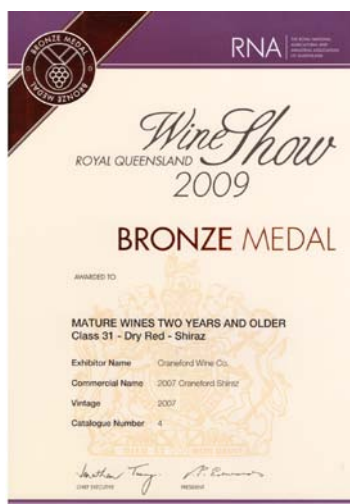

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The gorgeous 2002 Shiraz was aged in 85% French and 15% American oak. Dense red- purple; concentrated, deep blackberry and black pepper fruit on the bouquet is followed by a palate which is, happily, of medium body and not over- extracted. Here sweet blackberry fruit, supple tannins and subtle oak all contribute to a richly stylish wine.
