#### Viticulture and Production

*Varietal Composition: 95% Cabernet Sauvignon*

*GI/Appellation: Barossa Valley*

*Wood Treatment: American and French Oak*

*Maturation: 16 Months*

*Viticultural Notes: The majority of the fruit sourced for this wine came from the Angaston area of the Barossa Valley. The soil consists of shallow soil over stone. The vineyard is pruned to permanent arm with spurs.*

#### Winemakers Notes

*Colour: Brick red with purple hue*

*Nose: Red berry fruit with a herbaceous undertone and spice*

*Palate: Blackcurrant, mulberry and smooth tannins*

#### Tasting Notes

*A Cabernet Sauvignon dominated on nose and palate with mulberry, blackcurrant, berries and spice. An overall lovely Cabernet Sauvignon with smooth tannins and an herbaceous undertone.*
