### Viticulture and Production

*Varietal Composition: 100% Chardonnay*

*Wood Influence: Nil*

*Viticultural Notes: The fruit was sourced from a one grower vineyard located near Angaston. The fruit was all hand picked into 500kg bins. The vineyard is pruned to the method of rod and spur. During the winter months cereal cover crop is planted in the middle of the vine rows which is cut off during spring to improve the soil nutrient.*
