Varietal Composition: 100% Viognier

Wood Influence: Nil

Viticultural Notes: The fruit was sourced from a vineyard in the Adelaide Hills near Mt Torrens. The temperature conditions are a lot cooler throughout the whole ripening period. The vineyard is situated on a southern facing slope. The soil is a brown loam. The vineyard has foliage wires to let maximum sunlight into the canopy without impairing the fruit quality.

Nose: Apricot blossom, violets, white peach and citrus fruits.

Palate: Mouth filling with a banquet full of citrus and apricot.

A lovely balanced wine with sweetness and acid. An outstanding array of sweet apricot blossom and violets fill the nose. The palate shows characters of white peach and apricot which linger on.
